Instructions:

- Discuss a topic of your choice. Any topic will be fine as long as it is related to this course.
- **Collect your own data.** In other words, your work should not be just about your thought or summary of existing materials. There are a number of ways to collect your own data:
 - Take notes about communication scenes you find interesting in your everyday life.
 - Record conversations.
 - Questionnaire
 - Interview
- If you collect private data, clearly state the purpose of your study and obtain an agreement from your participants. Do not keep, copy or publish your data beyond the need of the course project.
- You will get extra points if your data enables a comparison between Japan and another culture, or a comparison within Japanese, such as age, gender, and dialectal differences.
- There is no strict rule for the number of pages, but just as a rough guide, I expect a 10-page double-spaced paper.
